

Hizb-ut Tahrir holds procession in Ctg, 4 held

Chittagong, July 6 (bdnews24.com) – Members of the banned Islamist militant outfit Hizb-ut Tahrir brought out a procession in Chittagong on Tuesday.

Police detained four people after the procession, suspecting them to be party members, Kotwali police chief Gazi Sakhawat Hossain told bdnews24.com.

Witnesses said that at around 1pm about 30-40 people, identifying themselves in a banner as Hizb-ut Tahrir party members, took out the procession from Love Lane and ended it at the same place only 10 minutes later. They abandoned the banner afterwards.

As the procession marched towards the Enayet Bazar intersection it faced obstruction from the patrol police, but defied the obstruction and went on to Love Lane.

The government banned the outfit on Oct 22, 2009. The party had previously organized a procession in the port city in April.
