

Immediately withdraw Indian navy ships from waters of Bangladesh

Hizb ut-Tahrir in Bangladesh organized a protest demonstration today (27th December, 2008) after Asr prayers in front of the national mosque demanding immediate withdrawal of Indian navy ships from Bangladeshi waters. Deputy Spokesman Kazi Murshedul Haque delivered the main speech. He said for the past 37 years India has tried to dominate Bangladesh. India is planning to loot the mineral resources of Bay of Bengal. They have illegally sent three ships to survey the region.
